Organized Youth Program Grant	<p>When a club provides a minimum \$1000 donation to an organized youth program (I.E. Boys and Girls club, Scouts, Guides, Navy League, etc.) the foundation will add an additional “top-up” of \$500 to that Youth Group.</p> <p>Club must have made minimum donation of \$15 / member to be eligible to participate.</p> <p><i>Maximum of \$7,000 available across Canada</i></p>	<p>Club must provide proof that it has provided funds to an Organized Youth program” along with request for reimbursement.</p> <p>Apply via email or Canada Post</p>	<p>Club must have already made the minimum donation of \$1000 to the organized youth program.</p> <p>Maximum “top up” of \$500.</p> <p>The “top up” cheque is payable to Youth Club</p>	<p>http://www.kfcdn.org/boysgirls.htm</p>

Send a Kid to Camp	<p>Send a Kid to Camp supports clubs who assist a child that requires financial assistance to attend Camp.</p> <p>Club must have made minimum donation of \$15 / member to be eligible to participate.</p> <p><i>Maximum of \$6,000 available across Canada</i></p>	<p>Club must provide proof that it has provided funds to “Send a Kid to Camp” along with request for reimbursement.</p> <p>Apply via email or Canada Post</p>	<p>Club must have already paid for the participant and provide proof.</p> <p>Foundation will reimburse 50% of Club’s costs to a maximum of \$500.</p> <p>Cheque is payable to Kiwanis Club</p>	<p>http://www.kfcdn.org/camp.htm</p>
