## THE MISSION STATEMENT

The Kiwanis Foundation of Canada was established in 1971 for the purpose of promoting Kiwanis and Kiwanis projects in Canada. It is a registered charity, dependent upon Kiwanis Members and Clubs for financial support, and dedicated to extending a helping hand to our Youth, the disadvantaged and to assist in times of Natural Disaster.

#### THE VISION STATEMENT

The Kiwanis Foundation of Canada will work for the continued extension of its mission and purposes through increased communication with Kiwanis Members and Clubs, making use of the Ambassador Program and the Foundation News Letter to solicit increased support. The Foundation will support new programs, promote new projects and encourage the expansion of Kiwanis in Canada.

## FINANCING

Donations are received primarily from individual Kiwanis Members and their Clubs in the three Districts of Kiwanis in Canada. Gifts from corporations, other foundations, groups and individuals are also received. All donations shall be used to carry out the Foundation's Vision.

## THE KIWANIS FOUNDATION OF CANADA AND THE **KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION AGREEMENT**

The Kiwanis International Foundation has agreed that a Club's Annual Contribution and the funds required for International Awards (Hixson, Tablet of Honour, etc.) can be paid to the Canadian Foundation and retained in Canada for use in KIF approved programs. Clubs will receive full recognition from the International Foundation.

growth and work of Kiwanis. Their service and dedication is remembered and honoured by their being named to this prestigious Fellowship. The Foundation sends a special scroll honouring their contribution and a uniquely designed medallion.

#### ADDITIONAL MEL OSBORNE FELLOWSHIP LEVELS.....

You have an opportunity to continue to honour your Mel Osborne Fellows by providing them with a Diamond Mel Osborne Fellowship for their continued service to Kiwanis and the communities they serve. The Diamond Fellowship has a distinctive coloured ribbon and a new diamond pin, which indicates the number of diamonds each fellow has received.

The various levels are achieved with a donation to the Foundation:

Mel Osborne Fellow: The basic level is available with a donation of \$750.00. The recipient receives a scroll, the Osborne Medallion with a gold blue neck ribbon and a lapel pin/tie tack.

Diamond Level One fellow: With a second donation of \$750.00, the recipient receives a second Osborne Medallion encased in a shadow box, a gold/burgundy neck ribbon and a special diamond pin.

Additional Diamond Level Awards: With additional donations of \$750.00 (each) the individual will receive a new tab with a number which will indicate the level the diamond Fellow has reached

#### WHEN REQUESTING A FELLOWSHIP.....

it is most important that donors identify the recipient of the award and that their particulars be clearly set out in all correspondence (name, address etc). The name should be correctly spelled and any other text you wish added to the scroll should be shown, so that the order can be properly entered with the name and club of a Kiwanian. If you have an intended date for presentation, be sure to include this and a phone number contact from your group. We will advise your Division Foundation Ambassador who will try to be in attendance for the presentation.
